Key: 10 = Excellent 1 = Insufficient / Total = 250 Points

In each column, a coefficient (x 1, 2, 3, 4) will be used to calculate the total number of points earned.

If the assessor fails to see a free ball situation for example, where a maximum total of 20 points are available for that category, then he/she must subtract the 20 points from the 250 point maximum before working out the percentage. This method does not then disadvantage a referee (percentage wise) who has a relatively easy match with no incidents.

Note: Additional remarks and comments about referees should be noted on the reverse
